



Landscape: Mixed Media Monotype

MATERIALS NEEDED

- 12 Tube set of Watercolors: e.g Winsor and Newton Cotman Watercolor Painting Plus Set Colors include: Cadmium Yellow Pale Hue, Cadmium Yellow Hue, Cadmium Red Pale Hue, Alizarin Crimson Hue, Ultramarine, Cobalt Blue Hue, Sap Green, Viridian Hue, Yellow Ochre, Burnt Sienna, Burnt umber, and Chinese White. (Two other student brands of tube watercolors that are inexpensive are Staedtler and Royal Langbridge, note: you may need to buy a separate small palette).
- Faber-Castell set of 24 Mini Soft Pastels in assorted colors
- Set of Watercolor Pencils – Faber-Castell Goldfaber Aqua set of 12 Colors in a tin (optional)
- 1 Windsor and Newton Mixed Media Paper Pad, Spiral Bound, 135lb paper (30 sheets), 11 x 14 inches
- 1 Speedball Brayer – 3 inch wide rubber roller
- 1 wooden spoon – to use as burnishing tool for printing (this is just a regular kitchen wooden spoon)
- 1 palette knife for color mixing – e.g Jack Richeson flat 3.5 inch palette knife
- Watercolor palette (if your watercolor set does not include it), white plastic rectangular style to hold wet paint
- Two pencils: HB Pencil (#2) and a Soft Pencil e.g Faber Castell 6B
- Ruler (12 inch)
- Eraser – White Staedtler (this could be used to cut up to make scraping tool) (optional)
- Brushes – e.g. Princeton Snap – size 4 round brush (for watercolor), and Princeton Real Value Natural Bristle Hair short handle set (9103) includes #3 Round, #4 Flat, and #8 Flat (used for printing inks)
- Water container
- Apron or shirt to wear while printing and painting

MATERIALS PROVIDED

Acrylic panels (14 x 18 inches) for monotype printing, palettes 12 x 12 inch acetate, for rolling out ink, printmaking inks, sponges, bamboo skewers, and wooden sticks, newsprint, nitrile gloves, water misting bottles, masking tape and miscellaneous card, scissors, color pencils, craft knife/s and small pieces of cardboard to use as scraping tools.
