



**Perspective Drawing**

## Supplies

Material	Type
Paper	<p><u>4 sheets of large smooth surface (hot pressed) 3-ply Bristol paper</u></p> <p><i>Cut the sheets in half to get 7 pieces of strong drawing paper.</i></p> <p><u>1 sheet of 40 lb. 25 in. x 38 in. Glama Natural Vellum Tracing Paper</u></p> <p><i>Cut the sheet in half to get two pieces of design vellum for drawings using the grid.</i></p>
Eraser	One <u>kneaded</u> , one <u>white rubber eraser</u>
Pencil Sharpener	<u>Handheld</u> is best
Pencils	<p><u>Graphite Pencils</u> in a range of grades:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● HB</li> <li>● 2B</li> <li>● 6B or 8B</li> </ul>
Drawing Board	<p>Any drawing board large enough to hold your paper. You will need clips to hold your paper while you draw. Some boards come with clips and some don't.</p> <p>Here is an example of <u>one that comes with clips</u>.</p> <p>Here are <u>some clips sold separately</u>.</p> <p><b>***DO NOT PAY A LOT FOR A DRAWING</b></p>

	<i>BOARD*** Any smooth large board will do as long as you have clips. Sometimes just going to a lumber yard or hardware store will be cheaper. If you have trouble finding something, don't worry about it as there are some spares at Art League.</i>
<b>T Square</b>	Metal is best, <a href="#">the 24 in. size will work well.</a>
<b>Ruler</b>	Any ruler will do as long as it's fairly long. <a href="#">Here's a metal one.</a>

## Optional Supplies

Students in the past have expressed an interest in these materials. They aren't required, but if you want to try them out, feel free!

<b>Material</b>	<b>Type</b>
<b>Sketchbook</b>	A sketchbook would be helpful to make Notes and quick preparatory sketches, but it is not required. Students can use their regular sketchbooks if they have one already.
<b>Colored Pencils</b>	The pencils need to be erasable. These are usually suggested for animators. <a href="#">The set of 12 should work.</a>
<b>Triangles</b>	<a href="#">These</a> are used to help set vanishing points on a grid. Not necessary but helpful. Usually you would get one of each, one 30/60 and one 45/90.
