MATERIALS NEED

Needed on first day of class:

- One (1) 2'x4' or 2'x3' piece of .5" Plywood
 - Please note, this will be carried back and forth each week. We will add handles for easy transport.
- [Two \(2\) yards cotton muslin fabric \(white or off-white\)](#)
 - 44" inches wide recommended
 - Avoid fabrics with heavy texture
 - Final yardage used in class depends on student
 - Anything purchased from a commercial fabric store like Joann Fabrics will need to be washed prior to class
- [Approx. 200 small T-pins, #20 or #16](#)
- Scissors

Needed by second day of class:

- X-Acto knife (or Olfa knife or something similar)
- T-square or L-square ruler
- Ultra Fine Sharpie
- [At least two \(2\) screen printing frames with 12xx multifilament or 110 mesh](#)
 - 10"x14" or 12"x18" recommended
- Duct tape or screen tape
- One (1) small / skinny rubber spatula
- [One \(1\) 6" or 8" squeegee](#)
 - NOT a fabric squeegee
 - Wooden handle recommended
- Two (2) rolls masking tape, 1" or 1.5"
- [One \(1\) spool of paper piecing black thread](#)
- Pencil
- Sketchbook
- Lint roller
- Smock or apron (to protect clothing from stains)

RECOMMENDED but optional:

- One (1) self-healing cutting mat
- One (1) hairdryer
