

Whiskers and Wings: Painting Birds, Mammals and Reptiles Laura Spector

MATERIALS NEED

- 1. One or two 12" x 12" up to 20" x 24" canvases, panels, or cradles (pre-primed)
- 2. An enlarged black and white photocopy of your animal photo to transfer
- 3. Saral Transfer Paper (Graphite)
- 4. Red ball point pen
- 5. Artist's tape

6. *Please note your list of paint colors contain a warm and cool of each primary color, followed by a list of earth colors. (NOTE: "C.P." refers to "Cadmium Pigment". These contain real cadmium which means a little will go a long way. It also means they cost a bit more. If you'd like to work with the hue, simply get Cadmium Yellow Medium, without the C.P. in the name.

Primary Colors:

- 1. Ultramarine Blue (PB 29)
- 2. Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Chromite Blue (PB 36:1)
- 3. C.P. Cadmium Yellow Primrose (PY 35)
- 4. C.P. Cadmium Yellow Medium (PY 37)
- 5. Quinacridone Crimson (PR 206 / PR 202), or Quinacridone Magenta (PR 122)
- 6. Pyrrole Red Light (PR 255), or Cadmium Red Medium (PR 108)

Earth Colors:

- 1. Yellow Ochre (PY 43), or Yellow Oxide
- 2. Burnt Sienna (PBr 7)
- 3. Raw Umber (PBr7), or French Raw Umber
- 4. Burnt Umber (PBr7)
- 5. Titanium White (PW 6) (This is a COOL white)
- 6. ACRYLIC PAINTERS ONLY- Zinc White (PW4) (This is a WARM white)
- 7. OIL PAINTERS ONLY Lead White (Cremnitz or Flake) (This is a WARM white)

8. Mediums

Acrylic Painters - water in a spray bottle, cup of water

Oil Painters - (optional) odorless turps in small container with lid and linseed oil, or 1 tube of matte acrylic paint with a dedicated hogshair brush.

I also like to use Stand Oil or Oleogel (by Natural Pigments) while building my painting

9. Brushes

- A variety of hogs hair and soft hair (natural or synthetic)
- 9. Towels (Acrylic white rags without texture, Oil blue paper towels)
- 10. Brush cleaner (bar of soap, or dish detergent)
- 11. Acrylic painters spray bottle and water cup
- 12. Painting clothes or apron
