

**MIXED MEDIA: OIL PASTELS**

# On Day 1, student must have:

- Oil Pastel set (\*See last page for details)
- Assorted Pencils
- Kneaded Rubber Eraser
- Sketchbook
- Drawing Board

Note: Sketchbook (If you are purchasing a new sketchbook I would recommend a mixed media pad size 7x10 or 12x9 that opens horizontally). Otherwise, you can use any sketchbook you already have.

## Other materials

- Black color pencil
- Faber-Castell PITT Fineliner Art Pen (Or black ink pen of any other brand but make sure is waterproof)
- Watercolor paper pad
- Assorted acrylic paint + Matte Medium
- Assorted watercolor paint
- Assorted brushes (for watercolor & acrylic)
- Workable fixative
- EnviroTex Lite® Kit (4oz Resin, 4oz Hardener)

## Optional

- Glassine paper (to protect your artwork for storage)
- Workable fixative

### \*Oil Pastel Set Info:

#### Recommended brands:

- <u>Sennelier Oil Pastels Standard And Grande Pastels</u>, <u>Mungyo Gallery Artist Soft Oil Pastel Sets</u>,
   Expressionist Extra Fine Quality Oil Pastels
  - <u>Texas Art Supply</u> does not sell Sennelier and Mungyo oil pastel, they only have Expressionist
    - Expressionist is the most affordable option
  - Mungyo Gallery pastels are not too expensive and they mix very well.
  - Sennelier are on the expensive side but are the best quality I have tried so far. You do
    not need to purchase a set of 50 colors +. You can start with a set of twelve or 24, and
    buy other colors individually. (You can buy individual Sennelier colors at Jerry's art
    Arama)
- In the case you buy a limited set (6 +) I would recommend purchasing other colors with low tonal value such as:
  - Ash blue, Blue-gray, pale pink (Sennelier)
  - o Pale Blue, ice blue, Naples yellow light, Rose madder (Mungyo)

## Be aware do not buy the following pastel sets:

- Sennelier Soft Pastel Sets
  - Yes, this is a Sennelier set but they are water soluble pastels and will not work when used as mix media for this course.
- Junior and Van Gogh brands do not mix well!
